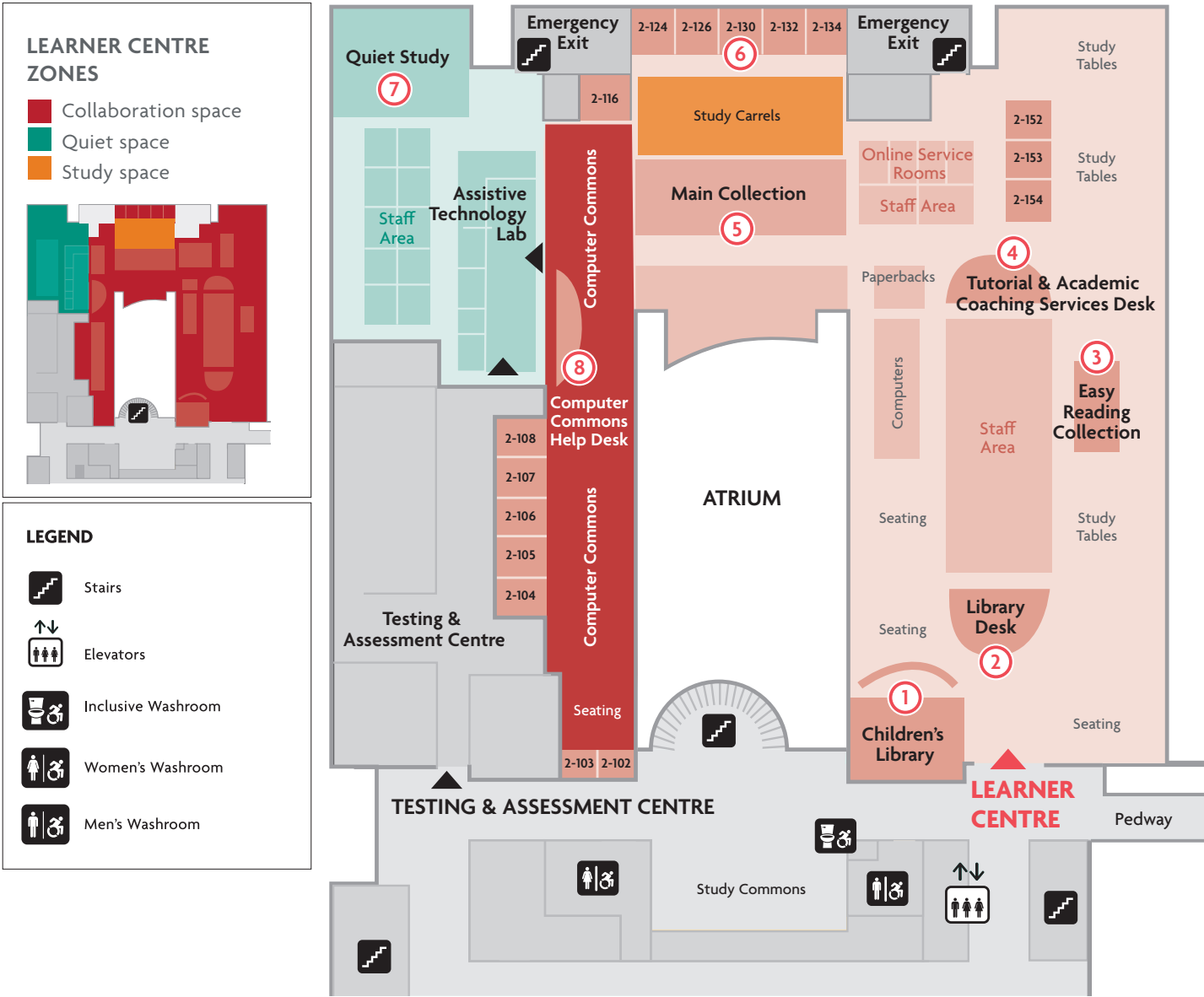
# NorQuest College Learner Centre

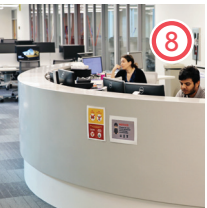
- Select one of 16 rooms for group study and book it on the library website for a maximum of two hours per day
