## 1 Children's "Ladybug" Library

- We have children's books, DVDs, audiobooks, and digital content
- Children must be under the direct supervision of an adult



## 2 Library Desk

- Use your Student ID to borrow NorQuest materials for 3 weeks.
- Ask us about borrowing materials from other libraries too!
- Renew materials using your NEOS account on the library website
- Return materials here or in the box on 1st floor of Heritage Tower
- Current textbooks can only be borrowed for 2 hours in the Learner Centre



## 3 Easy Reading Collection

- Choose books based on reading level and/or genre, indicated with stickers on the cover or spine
- Ask library staff for help locating and selecting materials



## 4 Tutorial Desk

- Seek one-on-one or group support with coursework from an English/writing tutor or a math/science tutor
- Sign in at the kiosk using your Student ID for a 15- to 20-minute drop-in session from Monday to Friday
- Stay nearby to make sure you hear the tutor call your name!

### Writing Centre

- Register on the library website to book a 30-minute appointment in person or online with either a writing tutor or a research librarian



## 5 Main Collection

- We have books, DVDs, audiobooks, and digital content
- Staff will put away the books, DVDs, and audiobooks



## 6 Student Meeting Rooms

- Select one of 16 rooms for group study and book it on the library website for a maximum of 2 hours per day



## 7 Quiet Study

- This area is for quiet individual study only



## 8 Computer Commons Desk

- Seek help with logging in to MyMail, MyQuest, and Moodle
- 80 computers are available on a first come, first served basis
- No food or drinks allowed at computers
